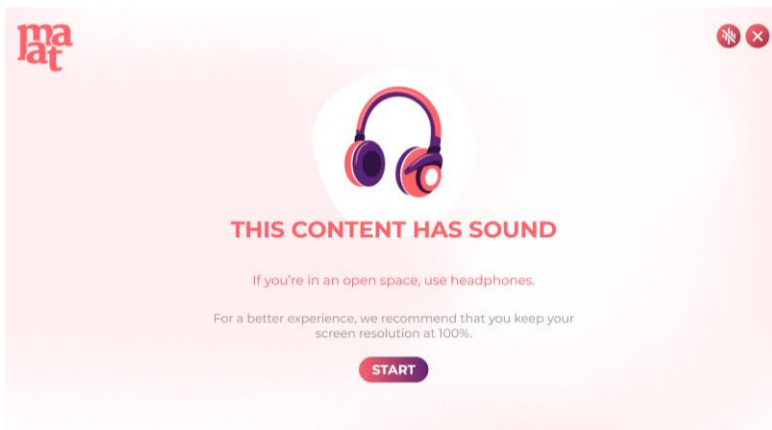


Explore Inclusivity with MAAT InclusiVille: A Serious Game for Inclusive Cities

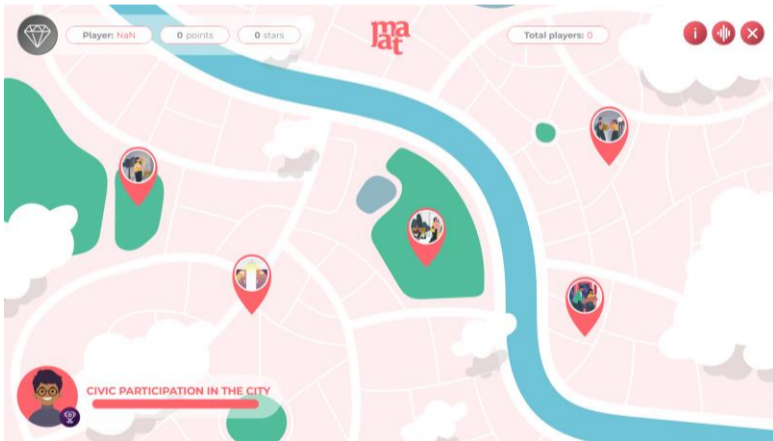


Objectives of MAAT InclusiVille:

5. Inspire youth to believe that their actions can shape the way cities function.

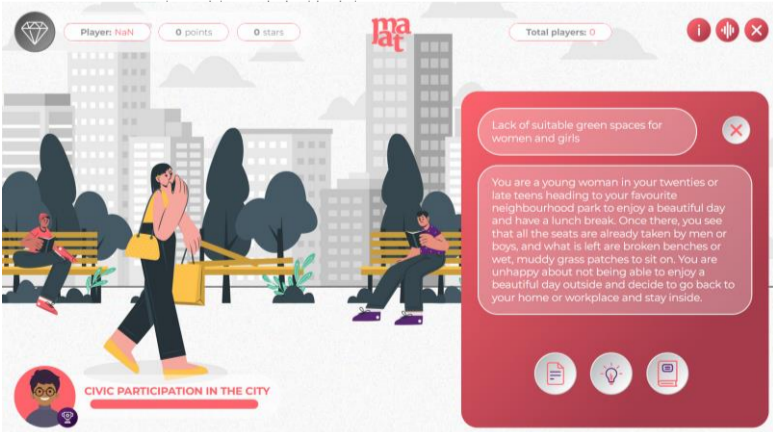
How It Works:
